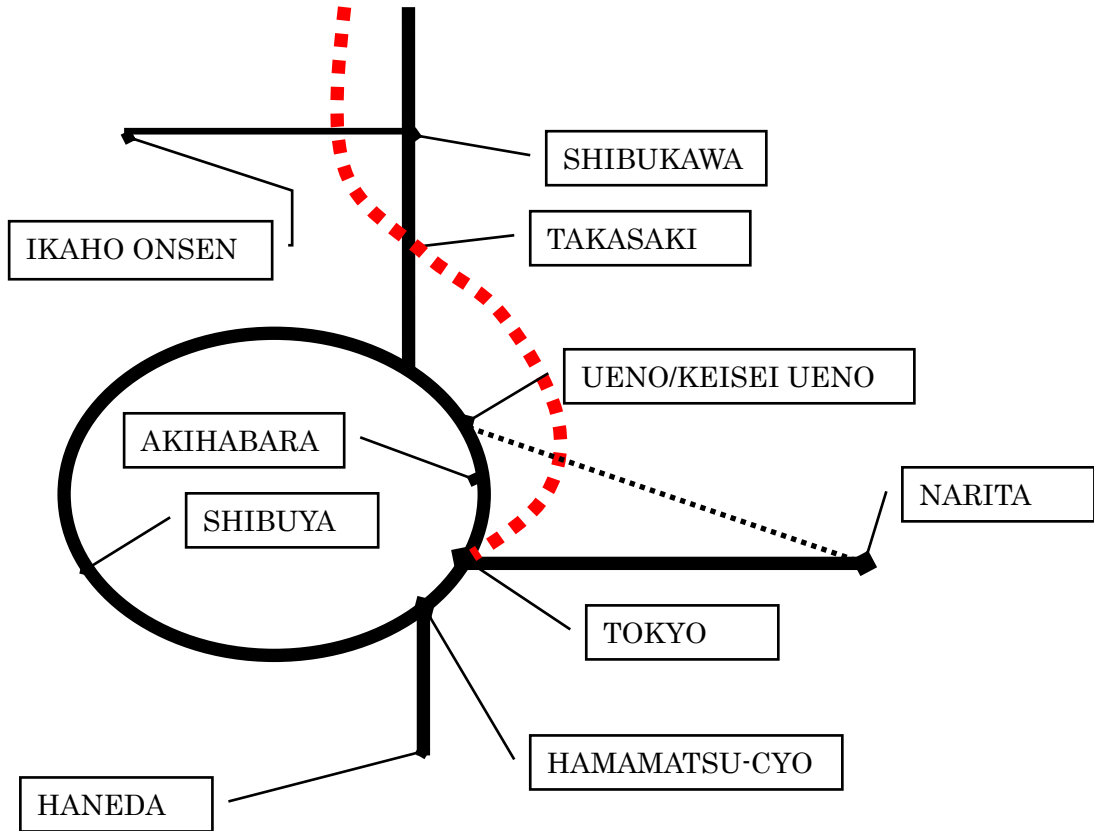

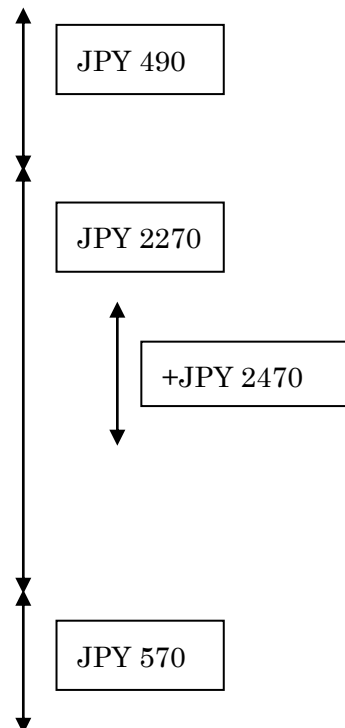

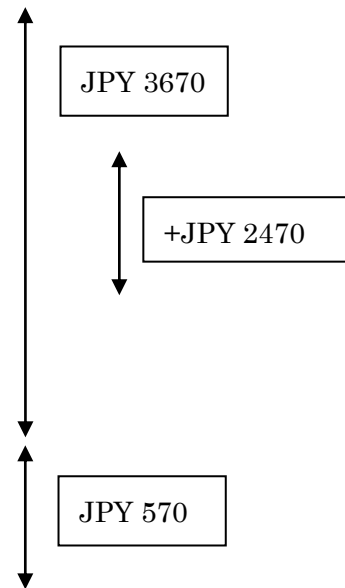

Town map

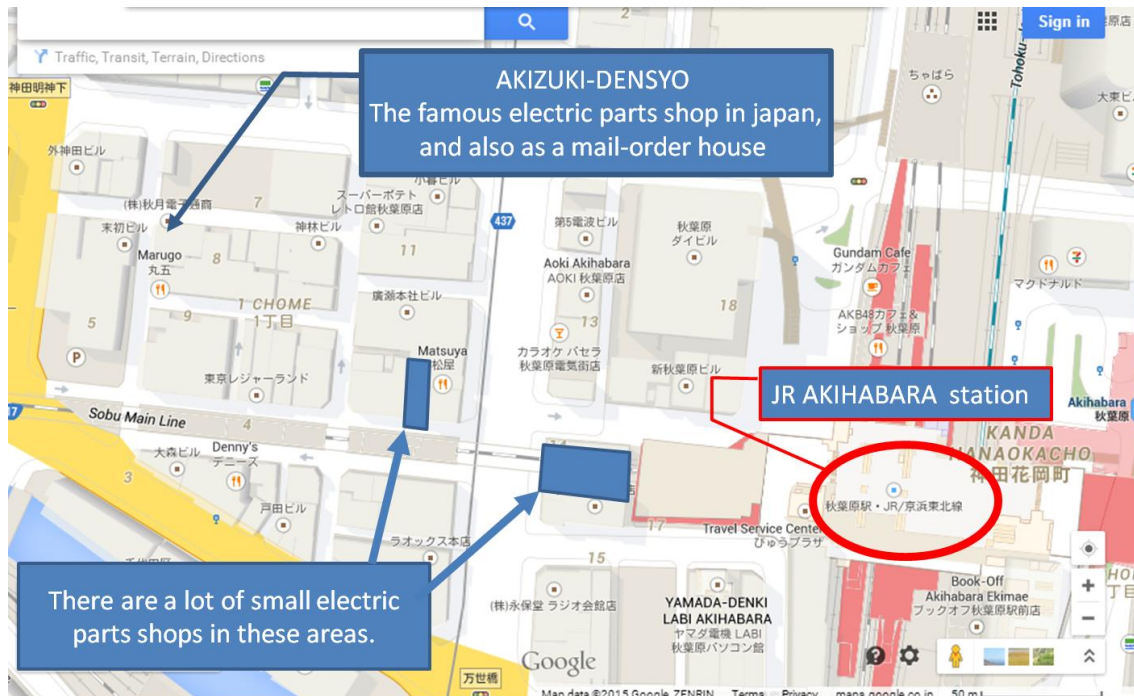
